## FRIDAY LETTER August 10, 2018

- 1. <u>Legal costs</u>. We have our first bills from the attorneys in the franchise suit: one from Richard Jonson for \$379.00 and a second from David Jurca for \$4,169.00. We have already deposited \$1,000, which will continue to be held in a trust account to cover anticipated costs in August. Without objection, I will go ahead and cut checks for these. You will recall that our share of total costs is 7.58% based on the number of customers.
- 2. <u>Generator for the booster station</u>. I met with the Cummins guy at the site this afternoon. He says they want to add a VFD to the big 50 horse motor so they can keep the generator size and cost down. We will clear the site, pour the slab and add a slated chain link fence.
- 3. <u>Sanitary survey tasks.</u> Dave has completed many of the smaller recommendations in the recent survey report. We will go over the complete list at the next Board meeting.
- 4. <u>Tree cutting follow up.</u> Dave and I will meet with the County enforcement people on Thursday, August 21<sup>st</sup> for what they are calling a "pre-application" meeting. I suspect there are many steps ahead of us before we resolve this complaint.
