1. <u>Wellpoint status.</u> I have attached a wellpoint status report for October that shows the results of Dave cleaning five poor performers. This increased the total raw water flow by a few gallons per minute.

Dave reports that he is noticing changes in the hydrology of Dockton Springs, with some areas getting wetter and others dryer. He doesn't think this is seasonal. Fortunately our total production is holding steady at a level which, when combined with the Sandy Shores well, will meet our year round demand at full build out.

- 3. <u>Dave's transition to Manager/Operator.</u> Dave and I have brainstormed the attached recommended scope-of-work for his new job.
