## FRIDAY LETTER April 13, 2018

1. Franchise update. We have received written confirmation from the County that we are considered to be in "good faith negotiations" over a new franchise. This will allow us to go ahead without interruption with the Windmill/97<sup>th</sup> project and any other work we need to do in the ROW.

Meanwhile our joint lawsuit is moving forward with some small changes. Tanner electric has dropped out of the group and the total cost estimate has gone down from \$66,000 to \$61,000 while our percent share of future costs has gone up from 7.58% to 8.20% (very small change and no increase in the estimate of our total cost at \$5,000. I have attached an Amended Legal Services Agreement with these changes that will need Hooper's signature. Perhaps we can just agree by e-mail?

- 2. <u>Connecting Hake and Manzanita</u>. Dave met at the site with Jerry O'Hare and they worked out all the details of the needed survey for the easement. This will likely happen next week.
- 3. <u>Manzanita PVC replacement</u>. Frank will be on vacation for most of April. He and Dave have scheduled the replacement for mid May.
- 4. Wellpoint Status Report. I have attached Dave's report for April. Little change from last month.
